



Prison Rape Elimination Act

Inmates have the right to be free from sexual misconduct.

The Department of Corrections has zero tolerance for all forms of sexual misconduct and all forms of retaliation against any person because of their involvement in the reporting or investigation of a PREA complaint.

Sexual misconduct includes but is not limited to:

- Aggravated sexual assault
- Inmate on inmate sexual assault
- Inmate on inmate sexual abuse
- Staff sexual misconduct
- Sexual harassment

You must immediately report any knowledge, suspicion, or information received regarding sexual misconduct to the DNR Site Supervisor. They will then contact the DOC Shift Commander.

If you are being sexually harassed by an inmate, properly document all interactions with the inmate and complete and incident report and/or infraction if applicable. Be sure that you discuss the situation with your supervisor.
