


Driving Directions



12200 Bordeaux Road, Littlerock, WA 98556

- From Olympia, take I-5 South. From Centralia, take I-5 North.
- Take exit 95, the Maytown-Littlerock exit, follow the road west to Littlerock.
- You will come to a stop sign, Littlerock Elementary School will be on the right, go straight.
- Follow the road straight past Littlerock Grocery.
- At the top of the hill, take a left onto Mima Rd.
- Go approximately 1½ miles and take the 1st right onto Bordeaux Rd. This is a DNR road.
- Cedar Creek is located approximately 5 miles down this road. After the first mile, follow the double yellow
 line to the end of the road. The Perimeter Control Office is where you will check-in. It is the log entry
 building across the road from Visitor Parking. Check in here by pressing the exterior button and pushing the
 door open and entering through the 2nd door.

Road Conditions

- Cedar Creek Corrections Center road construction has begun on Bordeaux Road. Detour signs are posted directing traffic.
- Be cautious and slow down.

Driving and Parking

- The speed limit on facility grounds is 15 mph. Thank you for not speeding.
- Go past the first entrance, proceed on to the second entrance where the large parking lot is located on your left.
- Check in at the PCO. The Perimeter Control Office (PCO) is located directly across from the parking lot.

Driving & Parking Information

Cedar Creek Corrections Center (CCCC)



- All vehicles will be parked and locked in the visitor parking lot.
- Drivers who provide transportation for visitors are to leave facility grounds immediately after, but not
 before the visitor(s) have been cleared for visiting. They are to return on time to pick up the visitor(s) at the
 end of the visiting period. The visitor is to have a contact phone number of the driver in case they need to
 leave the facility before the end of the visit period.
- Vehicles should be secured.
- Pets, other than authorized service animals, are not allowed on facility grounds.
- Service animals must be authorized and pre–approved prior to visit. Authorization is granted through the Superintendent or Designee.
- Pets and persons not visiting may not wait in the vehicles.
- Visitors will not return to their vehicles until they have signed out of the visiting area, or unless authorized to leave the visiting area by correctional staff.

Accessibility

Handicapped parking is available in the visitor's parking lot.
