- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Music was seen for a .100 Hearing on January 23, 2018 at the Washington State Penitentiary.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mrs. Ramsdell-Gilkey presented the case.

- Mr. Music is under the Board's jurisdiction in Walla Walla County Cause 64918 for Sodomy; Pierce County Cause 49659 for Unlawful Possession of Firearm by Certain Person; and Escape in the First Degree in Walla Walla County Cause 66971. He has previous convictions for three counts of Attempted Robbery; Robbery and Murder in the First Degree in King County Cause 500024. Mr. Music originally received a death sentence for the Murder in the First Degree conviction out of King County. He was later resentenced to life with the possibility of parole.

Mr. Music was involved in a serious of attempted robberies and a robbery in 1969 when he committed the murder. The criminal activity involved Mr. Music and his crime partners pulling up in their car alongside individuals and demanding money at gunpoint. The murder involved Mr. Music and crime partners pulling up alongside two teenage males who were walking. He got out of the car and at gunpoint demanded the 15 year old's coat. When the boy ran, Mr. Music shot him. The victim later died from the gunshot wound. Mr. Music was 19 years old at the time of this crime and is currently 68 years of age.

Mr. Music was convicted in 1976 of the Sodomy which involved a group assault against another inmate. He also committed the escape from the Washington State Penitentiary in 1976 and was found in Pierce County with two hand guns.

Mr. Music risk assessments rate him as a low risk to re-offend.

Mr. Music has had approximately 18 serious infractions during his incarceration with the last one occurring in June of 2017 for striking another offender after that offender would not leave him alone.

Mr. Music has participated in Graphic Design classes and Upholstery classes. He has completed Victim Awareness; Breaking Barriers; Stress/Anger Management; Chemical Dependency; his GED; Human Relations; Vocational Writing, Mathematics for the Trades and Mood Management Group. He is scheduled to begin Roots of Success and Redemption. Mr. Music is involved in Sustainable Practices Lab (SPL) and working in the greenhouse.

Recommendation: The panel recommends the Board maintain the previous decision of conditionally parolable to a Mutual Re-Entry Plan (MRP).

Next Action: Schedule .100 Hearing 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date (PERD).
