- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Spruel was seen for a Release Hearing on January 30, 2018 at the Airway Heights Correction Center.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Spruel is being reviewed by the Board in King County Cause 96-1-07935-5 for Rape in the First Degree. He has other convictions under this cause which he has served for Kidnapping in the First Degree, Rape in the First Degree, Assault in the Second Degree and Robbery in the First Degree.

The crime involved Mr. Spruel and his crime partners abducting a woman from a car wash after assaulting her and her boyfriend and stealing their vehicle. The victim was taken to a secluded area where Mr. Spruel physically

and sexually assaulted her. Mr. Spruel was 17 years old at the time of the crime and is currently 38 years of age.

Mr. Spruel has an extensive juvenile history.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate to low risk to re-offend.

Mr. Spruel has had a total of thirty-four infractions while incarcerated with the last one occurring in 2011 for drug use.

Mr. Spruel has completed the Intensive Outpatient Program, Thinking for a Change, and the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program Core and Aftercare where he received favorable reports. He has completed vocational programming and earned his AA Degree. He receives good reports for his participation in offender change programs.

Mr. Spruel has good community support but would like to live in a transitional house such as House of Mercy.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Mr. Spruel be found releasable in October 2019 upon satisfactory completion of a transition through lower levels of custody.

Next Action: Submit Offender Release Plan (ORP) in November of 2018.
