- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Hunsaker was seen for a .100 Hearing on February 6, 2018 at the Monroe Correctional Complex – Twin Rivers Unit.

- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Balmert presented this case.

Mr. Hunsaker is currently under the jurisdiction of the Board in King County Cause 82-1-02588-3 for Statutory Rape in the First Degree Count III and Burglary in the First Degree Count VI. He has reached is statutory maximum on Statutory Rape in the Second Degree Count III; Assault in the Second Degree Count IV; Indecent Liberties Count V; and Statutory Rape in the Third Degree Count VII.

The crimes occurred between August 1979 and May 1982. Mr. Hunsaker approached six Asian children between the ages of 8 and 16 in their homes

while their parents were not present. He gained entry to their home under the guise of a school official that need to conduct a physical exam. He would measure the children and sexually molest the females. Mr. Hunsaker was between the ages of 40 to 50 when these crimes occurred. He is currently 83 years of age.

Mr. Hunsaker has an extensive sexual criminal history to include Lewdness in Richland, Washington in 1958; Lewd and Lasciviousness Act in Montana in 1967 and a Lewd and Lascivious Act upon a Child in Montana in January 1968.

Risk assessment scores rate him as moderate to high with a trend toward lowered risk to re-offend.

Mr. Hunsaker has no serious infractions.

Mr. Hunsaker has completed the Sex Offender and Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP) twice as well as aftercare. He has also completed Bridges to Life.

Mr. Hunsaker would like to work as an Estimator for a Landscaping Company that his son owns. This would be office work. He has good family and community support. He is also be eligible for Social Security.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends he be found conditionally parolable to a Mutual Re-entry Plan and adds 18 months to his minimum term.
