- Mr. Coker was seen for a .100 hearing at the Washington Corrections Center on February 21, 2018.
  
- **Summary Discussion**  
Ms. Balmert presented this case.

Mr. Coker is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Whatcom County Cause 82-1-00310-0 for Rape in the First Degree and Burglary in the First Degree.

The crime involved stalking and harassment of the victim which lead to the kidnap, rape and burglary of the victim. Mr. Coker was 25 years old at the time and is currently 60 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a low to moderate risk to re-offend. His risk is further mitigated by age and health issues.

Mr. Coker has a total of 20 serious infractions. He has had no serious infractions since his last hearing in January of 2017.

Mr. Coker has completed multiple programs to include Bridges to Life, Re-entry Life Skills and Making a Good Brain Great. He completed a number of other programs prior to his last hearing in 2015 to include Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP) in 1997. He is unable to go to camp due to medical needs.

Mr. Coker would like to release to a Mack House in Snohomish or King County.

- **Recommendation:** The panel finds Mr. Coker parolable.
