Risk assessments rate him at a moderate risk to re-offend.

The Board is reviewing Mr. Delgado's case under RCW 9.94A.730 for his Spokane County Cause 92-1-01764-5 Conspiracy to Commit Robbery and Murder in the First Degree. He also has a Burglary 1 conviction out of Spokane for which the time has been served.

Mr. Delgado and his accomplices planned to rob a Spokane Pizza establishment using disguises and a weapon. They initially went to the Pizza store, but there was too much activity and police presence. They decided to order pizza for delivery and rob the delivery person. The delivery person arrived at the order location and Mr. Delgado shot him as he got out of his

vehicle. Mr. Delgado ran and his accomplices checked the victim for cash. Mr. Delgado was 17 years old at the time and is currently 42 years of age.

Mr. Delgado has had many serious infractions over the year, but they have lessened over time with the last serious infraction occurring in 2011.

Due to his sentence structure, Mr. Delgado has not been able to do much programming. The Board would like him to complete Thinking for a Change and Bridges to Life.

Mr. Delgado would like to release to his Mother in Eastern Washington and also has a fiancé who is very supportive. Her family is supportive as well.

The Board would like Mr. Delgado to participate in more programming and remain infraction free until he is seen again.

- **Recommendation:** The panel finds Mr. Delgado not releasable. Re-submit petition in thirty six months or March of 2020.
