- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Buegler is under the Board's jurisdiction in Clark County Cause 79-1-00056-6 for Murder in the First Degree. The crime involved Mr. Buegler entering the home of a former girlfriend and shooting two males inside the house. The first male died from the gun shots and the second male survived. Mr. Buegler was 29 years old at the time of the offense and is currently 67 years of age.

Mr. Buegler also served time for an Assault Third Degree in Clark County Cause 10235 which reached its statutory maximum on July 10, 1984.

Mr. Buegler has had a total of 20 serious infractions through his incarceration.

Mr. Buegler is currently at work release and has been participating in job search activities daily and appears to be very motivated to get a job. Mr. Buegler has completed educational programs.

Mr. Buegler stated he would like to be gainfully employed and maintain a clean and sober lifestyle in the Cowlitz County area.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Mr. Buegler be found parolable and that no time be added to his minimum term. The panel would like to see him complete his programming in work release and submit an offender release plan in April 2017.
