- An updated prosecutor recommendation was received recommending that Mr. Lakey not be released.

- Mr. Lakey was seen for a .100 hearing on March 13, 2018 at Stafford Creek Correction Center.

- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Rongen presented this case.

Mr. Lakey is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Thurston County Cause 79-1-82-9 for Murder in the First Degree.

Mr. Lakey met the victim at a bar where he was celebrating his 21st birthday. After spending some time with her at the bar, they went back to her house because she had a room to rent. She was not receptive to his sexual advances. He fought with her, stabbed her and raped her. After murdering the victim he drove from town to town in her car until he had an accident

and was arrested. He was 21 years of age at the time of the crime and he is currently 60 years of age.

He has a 1974 juvenile conviction for indecent liberties. The victim was a six year old boy.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate to high risk to re-offend.

Mr. Lakey has had 35 infractions throughout his incarceration with the last one occurring in 2013 when he tested positive for methamphetamines.

Mr. Lakey refuses to complete the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP). He has little to no insight into his behavior.

He does work as a Food Worker and receives above average to superior ratings.

- **Recommendation:** The panel finds Mr. Lakey not parolable and adds 60 months to his minimum term.
Next Action: Schedule .100 Hearing 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date (PERD). If he completes the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP) prior to his PERD, the Board will see him earlier.
