- An updated prosecutor recommendation was received recommending against release.

- Mr. Coronel-Perez was seen for a release hearing at the Stafford Creek Corrections Center on March 13, 2018.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Coronel-Perez is being seen by the Board in Lewis County Cause 97-1-00194-8 for Murder in the First Degree Count I and Reckless Endangerment in the First Degree Count II.

The crime involved Mr. Coronel-Perez fired a gun out of his car into another car while on the freeway killing a passenger and endangering the lives of the driver and a child. Mr. Coronel-Perez was 17 years of age at the time of the crime and is currently 38 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a low to low-moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Coronel-Perez has committed 13 total infractions during his incarceration with the last one occurring in 2000.

Mr. Coronel-Perez has completed several offender change programs as well as education programs and has received positive reports.

Mr. Coronel-Perez has detainer to Mexico and will be deported when he is released. He has good family support in Mexico.

- **Recommendation:** The panel finds him releasable on or about July of 2018.
