- **Summary Discussion**

Mrs. Lori Ramsdell-Gilkey presented this case.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate to low risk to re-offend.

Mr. Gilbert is under the Board's jurisdiction in Mason County Cause C-1132 for two counts of Kidnapping in the First Degree. He was also sentenced for Arson Second Degree Count III in this cause which reached its maximum expiration date on February 29, 2000. The kidnappings involved Mr. Gilbert abducting two women in front of a bar as they were getting into their vehicles. He had a knife and forced the two women to drive him to a remote area. He raped and robbed both women and assaulted them. Mr. Gilbert was 29 at the time of the offense and he is currently 64 years of age.

His last serious infraction was in 2013 for trying to remove ID from a speaker.

He has completed the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP) and some Max Benefits. He is involved in the Horticulture Program.

At Mr. Gilbert's last hearing he was found conditionally parolable to a Mutual Re-Entry Program and thirty-six months were added to his minimum to complete transition. He has transferred to the Monroe Correctional Complex – MSU. He has completed the Goodwill New Connections Program while at the MSU. He receives regular visits form family and he has a referral to a substance abuse program and is waiting to be accepted. His transfer to the Monroe Correctional Complex – MSU dormitory setting has been stressful but he has done well.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that he be found parolable. Next action is to submit an Offender Release Plan (ORP).
