- Mr. Anderson was seen for a .100 hearing at the Coyote Ridge Corrections Center on March 20, 2018.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mrs. Ramdell-Gilkey presented this case.

Mr. Anderson is currently under the jurisdiction of the Board in Spokane County Cause 79-1-00490-2 for Kidnapping in the First Degree Counts XII and XIII and Robbery in the First Degree Count IV. He has yet to serve Rape in the First Degree Count V and Robbery in the First Degree Count VI for this cause which run consecutive to Counts XIV, XV and IV.

Mr. Anderson previously served Spokane County Cause 79-1-00490-2 for Robbery in the First Degree (While Armed with a Deadly Weapon) Count I;

Assault in the Third Degree Count II, Escape in the Second Degree Count VI, and Robbery in the First Degree Count XI.

Prior to the Spokane County convictions, Mr. Anderson served time for Benton County Cause 78-025 Robbery in the First Degree (While Armed with a Deadly Weapon); Benton County Cause 78-054 Rape in the First Degree (While Armed with a Deadly Weapon) Count I; Robbery in the First Degree (While Armed with a Deadly Weapon) Count II; Kidnapping in the First Degree (While Armed with a Deadly Weapon) Count III, and Kidnapping in the First Degree (While Armed with a Deadly Weapon) Count IV and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm Count V.

Mr. Anderson's crimes involved a three month period of time where he committed robberies, rapes, assaults and kidnappings. . He started with a robbery at the Liberty Theater in Pasco which turned into kidnapping and rape. He then moved on to two Pasco motels where he continued to rob, kidnap and assault women after he forced his way into their rooms. He was arrested following the robbery of a Safeway store in Pasco. Two months later he escaped from jail, snuck into a home in Pasco and was surprised by the victim who returned home to find him hiding in her basement. He assaulted her, subdued her children, a neighborhood friend and her husband and held guns to her children's heads while threatening them. He took the woman, using the family vehicle, to Benton County where he raped her, robbed a store where he kidnapped another person and fled with the two hostages to Seattle where he was apprehended by a Seattle Police SWAT Team. Mr. Anderson was 25 years old at the time of the crimes and is currently 64 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as an elevated risk to re-offend, however, he has made significant progress towards dynamic risk factors.

Mr. Anderson has had no serious infractions since 2006.

Mr. Anderson has not completed much programming due to his lengthy sentence, but he does work all the time.

Mr. Anderson's wife has been with him through his incarceration. He adult children are supportive.

- **Recommendation:** The panel finds Mr. Anderson parolable from Spokane County Cause 79-1-00490-2 Counts IV, XII, XIII, XIV, and XV to Counts V and VI effective June 14, 2018.

Next Action: Schedule Redetermination Hearing within six months to address the minimum term on the remaining two counts.
