Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a low risk to re-offend.

Mr. Charliaga was seen at the Coyote Ridge Corrections Center for a .100 hearing on March 21, 2017.

Mr. Charliaga is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Cowlitz County Cause #7223 for Aggravated First Degree Murder Count I and Murder in the First Degree Count II.

The crime involved the murder of two teenage boys as Mr. Charliaga and his crime partners were robbing them for their marijuana. Mr. Charliaga was 27 years old at the time of the crime and is currently 65 years of age.

Mr. Charliaga has a total of 119 serious infractions with the last one occurring after his last hearing in 2011.

Mr. Charliaga is working on his AA Degree and has also completed the following programs: Job Seeking Skills, Getting it Right, CD Treatment, Life Skills Computing, ITC, and Stress Anger Management.

Mr. Charliaga has no release plan at this time, but would like to work with native carving and volunteer at the soup kitchens. He does receive tribal support and VA benefits.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that he be found conditionally parolable to a Mutual Re-entry Plan (MRP), and that no time be added to his minimum term. Schedule .100 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date (PERD).
