Mr. Sahlberg presented this case.

Risk assessment scores rate him at a moderate to high risk to re-offend.

Mr. Erickson was seen for a .100 hearing at the Washington State Penitentiary on March 21, 2017.

Michael Erickson is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Snohomish County Cause #80-1-01103-5 for Assault in the First Degree with a Habitual Criminal finding. While Mr. Erickson was incarcerated at the Washington State Reformatory for prior convictions of Murder in the Second Degree and Assault in the Second Degree, he and another inmate attacked a Corrections Officer. He was 19 years of age when this assault took place.

He has prior convictions in Benton County Cause 78-078 and 78-118 for Murder in the Second Degree and Assault in the Second Degree. The murder involved the beating to death of a man Mr. Erickson and another man thought was a police informant. The assault occurred in the jail while awaiting sentencing for the murder and involved Mr. Erickson and another inmate beating another inmate. Mr. Erickson was 17 years of age at the time of these offenses and he is currently 56 years of age.

Mr. Erickson received a Final Discharge on June 29, 2014, but his parole was suspended and revoked through the violation process when he committed Assault in the Third Degree out of Pierce County. This Assault in the Third Degree will be served consecutively to the Assault in the First Degree.

Mr. Erickson has 35 serious infractions, one of which resulted in the Assault in the First Degree Conviction when he stabbed the Corrections Officer.

Mr. Erickson continued his criminal activity even after receiving a Final Discharge, therefore the Board revoked the Final Discharge.

Mr. Erickson would like to release to the Tacoma area and obtain his CDL license.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends a finding of not parolable and adds 24 months to his minimum term. The Board would like him to complete Thinking for a Change.
