Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Reed was seen by the Board for a parolability hearing on March 21, 2017 at the Washington State Penitentiary.

Mr. Reed is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Okanogan County Cause #06355 for Assault in the First Degree While Armed with a Deadly Weapon.

The instant offense involved Mr. Reed assaulting another inmate at the Okanogan County Jail while in custody for charges of Murder 1 and Robbery. He was found not guilty by reason of insanity for the Murder 1 and Robbery.

Mr. Reed was 27 at the time of the instant offense and is currently 71 years of age.

Mr. Reed did not come to the hearing and did not participate in the psychological evaluation. He is currently housed in the hospital unit at the Washington State Penitentiary.

Mr. Reed has committed 20 serious infractions during his incarceration with the last one occurring in 2013.

Offender Change: Mr. Reed has not completed much programming because he resides in the hospital unit. He has participated in mental health treatment and counseling.

Mr. Reed has no release plans at this time.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that 90 months be added to his minimum term. Schedule .100 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date.
