- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Sahlberg presented this case.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate to high risk to re-offend.

Mr. Robinson was seen by the Board for a parolability hearing on March 21, 2017 at the Washington State Penitentiary after his supervision was revoked in 2016.

Mr. Robinson is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Kittitas County Cause 83-1-00050-4 for Assault in the First Degree with a Habitual Criminal finding and Kittitas County Cause #83-1-00051-2 for Possession of Stolen Property in the Second Degree with a Habitual Criminal finding.

The crime involved Mr. Robinson shooting a State Patrol Trooper with a stolen gun when the Trooper stopped Mr. Robinson to talk with him about unlawfully hitchhiking on Interstate 90. The Trooper was shot in the leg and stomach. Mr. Robinson was 31 years old at the time of the crime and is currently 64 years of age.

Mr. Robinson has an extensive juvenile criminal history in Montana, North Dakota and Washington State.

Infractions: He has a total of 92 infractions including four new infractions that involve anti-social behavior.

Mr. Robinson has completed Stress Anger Management, Victim Awareness, Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT), Thinking for A Change, Right Living, Chemical Dependency and multiple vocational classes. He is currently participating in mental health treatment. However, he shows little or no demonstrable change after multiple intense programs and opportunities on parole.

Mr. Robinson has no structured release plan at this time.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends finding him not parolable and adding 48 months to the minimum term. Schedule .100 Hearing 120 days prior to parole eligibility review date (PERD).
