- **Summary Discussion**

Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate to high risk to re-offend.

Mr. Steiner was seen at the Washington State Penitentiary for a .100 Hearing on March 21, 2017.

Mr. Steiner is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Kitsap County Cause #83-1-00191-7 for Statutory Rape in the First Degree. The crime involved Mr. Steiner penetrating the anus of a known two year old male with an object that caused severe damage. Mr. Steiner was 27 years old at the time and is currently 60 years of age.

Mr. Steiner has a total of 23 serious infractions including one new infraction for refusing a cell assignment.

Mr. Steiner has completed Stress Anger Management, Victim Awareness, chemical dependency and several vocational programs. He is currently participating in Graphic Design classes and mental health treatment. He has demonstrated little to no change after programming and has three failed attempts at parole.

Mr. Steiner release plan includes collecting SSI and getting needed medical treatment. He does not want to die in prison.
