- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Frick was seen for a .100 hearing at the Monroe Correctional Complex – Washington State Reformatory/MSU on April 3, 2018.

- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Balmert presented this case.

Mr. Frick is under the jurisdiction of the Board in King County Cause 82-1-03262-6 for Count I Rape in the Second Degree; Count II Rape in the First Degree (While Armed with a Deadly Weapon); and Count III Attempted Rape in the Second Degree.

In Count I, Mr. Frick attended a party at the residence of the victim and her boyfriend. When the party was over, Mr. Frick left to take another friend home. He returned to the residence later when the victim was alone and entered the apartment under the guise that he had forgotten something.

When they reached the bedroom, Mr. Frick grabbed the victim and sexually assaulted her. In Count II, Mr. Frick entered the apartment of a female without her knowledge. She lived in the same complex where Mr. Frick had been staying. When she got up at 2:00 a.m. to get a glass of water, she was accosted by Mr. Frick as she returned to her bed. Mr. Frick produced a knife and sexually assaulted her. In Count III Mr. Frick had met the victim a couple days prior to the offense and invited her to a local tavern. They returned to her apartment to listen to music and he attempted to sexually assault her when a neighbor heard her cries and called 911. The victim was able to flee her apartment and summon law enforcement assistance. Mr. Frick was 32 years old at the time of the crimes and is currently 68 years of age.

Mr. Frick has a previous conviction for Burglary in the First Degree.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate to high risk to re-offend which is mitigated by his age and health.

Mr. Frick has had no serious infractions since his last hearing in 2011.

Mr. Frick has completed the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program and Max Benefits. He has completed Intensive Out-Patient Treatment, is currently involved in Home Builders, and has completed Bridges to Life.

Mr. Frick would like to release to a group home in Lake Tapps. He would also like to release to his sister in Ohio.
