- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Ms. Murphy was seen for a .100 Hearing on April 12 2017 at the Washington Corrections Center for Women. She currently resides at the Peninsula Work Release.

Risk assessment scores rate her as a low risk to re-offend.

Ms. Murphy is under the Board's jurisdiction in Thurston County Cause #83-1-171-8 for two counts of Murder in the First Degree and one count of Arson in the First Degree.

The crime description involves Ms. Murphy shooting both her parents in the family home and then setting fire to the home. She was 19 years old at the time of the crimes and is currently 54 years of age.

Ms. Murphy has had a total of 11 serious infractions with the last one being in 1997.

Ms. Murphy has completed an extraordinary number of programs, has participated in many hours of therapy and has taken a very active role in her rehabilitation to include taking full advantage of the opportunities available to her in the Department of Corrections.

Ms. Murphy was found conditionally parolable to a Mutual Re-Entry Plan at her last hearing. She is now residing at Peninsula Work Release and has been there 35 days prior to her hearing. She is taking full responsibility for what she has done. She has a lot of support in the community, and she has a full time job at a plant nursery and works weekends at a restaurant.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Ms. Murphy be found parolable. The next action is to submit and offender release plan.
