Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Ms. Robinson was seen for a release hearing on April 12, 2017 at the Mission Creek Corrections Center for Women.

Risk assessment scores rate her as a low risk to re-offend.

Ms. Robinson is convicted of Murder in the First Degree in King County Cause #96-1-03088-7.

The crime involved Ms. Robinson going to a man's apartment that she had met earlier in the day. She shot the man and stole the victim's credit cards and checkbook. She was 17 years old at the time of the crime and she is currently 38 years of age.

Ms. Robinson has 10 serious infractions with the last one occurring in 1998.

Ms. Robinson has completed several programs and training which include obtaining her GED. She has been referred for Stress/Anger Management, Thinking for a Change, Beyond Trauma, and Roots of Success. She participates in extended family visits with her mother and continues to participate in Toast Masters, Making it Work, Mock Interviews and the Prison Pet Partnership Program.

Ms. Robinson said she petitioned the Board so she could tell her story. She said the victim was not trying to sexual assault her as she originally had claimed and she went to his apartment to rob him.

Ms. Robinson is at Mission Creek Correction Center for Women which is a work camp. She is pre-approved for Fare Start in Seattle. Her mother is her back-up. Although Ms. Robinson's ERD is May of 2018, she understands if she is released earlier this will put her under the Board for supervision.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Ms. Robinson be found releasable. Release in January of 2018
