- Mr. Dearbone was seen for a .100 hearing at the Airway Heights Corrections Center on April 17, 2018.
- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Dearbone is under the jurisdiction of the Board in King County Cause #65631 for Murder in the First Degree. He has previous convictions for Indecent Liberties and Burglary in the Second Degree out of King County which have reached their statutory maximum.

The crime involved the murder of Mr. Dearbone's male cousin. The victim was left in the woods and did not succumb to his injuries for two days. Mr. Dearbone was on probation at the time of the murder. He was 28 years old when he committed this crime and is currently 73 years of age.

Mr. Dearbone's other convictions for Indecent Liberties and Burglary in the Second Degree involved the sexual assault of a six year old girl and burning a house occupied by an individual with whom he was angry.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Dearbone's last serious infraction was in 2017. Although he has had a significant reduction for infractions in the last several years, the Board is concerned about this serious infraction in December of 2017.

Mr. Dearbone has completed the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP); and the Redemption Program. The Board would like him to complete Thinking for a Change and Bridges to Life prior to his next hearing.

Mr. Dearbone does have family support.

- **Recommendation:** The panel finds him not parolable and adds 36 months to his minimum term.

Next Action: Schedule .100 120 days prior to parole eligibility review date (PERD). The Board would like Mr. Dearbone to complete Bridges to Life and Thinking for a Change.
