- A new prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Smith was seen for a .100 Parolability Hearing at the Coyote Ridge Corrections Center on May 17, 2017.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a low to moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Smith is under the jurisdiction of the Board in King County Cause 37443 for Murder in the First Degree. When Mr. Smith was 16 years of age, he pulled a nine year old female neighbor into his garage and made her disrobe. The victim found a knife and Mr. Smith took it away from her and stabbed her to death. He left her body in the garage and later set fire to the building to dispose of her body.

While on parole in 1977 at the age of 31, allegations were made that he raped a college student. His parole was suspended and reinstated. At the age of 33, he assaulted a woman at knifepoint with the intent to rape her. The victim was able to escape and Mr. Smith's parole was revoked. He is currently 71 years of age.

Mr. Smith has had a total of 5 serious infractions with the last one in 2011 for possession of razor blades.

Mr. Smith completed the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP) and some aftercare where he made minimal progress. He also completed chemical dependency treatment and aftercare. He was moved away from where those programs are available due to his medical condition.

Mr. Smith would like to release to the Union Gospel Mission where he has case management, access to services and a religious sponsor.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Mr. Smith be found parolable and that he submit an offender release plan.
