- **Hearing:** Mr. Espinoza was seen by the Board on May 17, 2017 at the Coyote Ridge Corrections Center for a release hearing.
- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a low to moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Espinoza is incarcerated for Yakima County Cause 96-1-00884-8 for Murder in the First Degree and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by Certain Person.

The crime involved Mr. Espinoza shooting the victim in Sunnyside, Washington. He was transported to the hospital and was declared deceased upon arrival. The police received information that the victim was shot by

someone in a White Continental. When they were questioned by police, the passengers of that vehicle identified Mr. Espinoza as the person who fired the gun. Mr. Espinoza was 17 years old at the time of the murder and is currently 38 years of age.

Mr. Espinoza has committed 22 infractions during his incarceration with the last one occurring in 2007 for fighting.

Mr. Espinoza has completed copious amounts of programming to include completing two different Associate of Arts degrees for general studies and welding. He also has a bookkeeping certificate. He has taken any program available to him and completed his GED in 2001. He has worked in the dog program as a mentor and trainer and currently is employed in the facility as a custodian and welding technology.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Mr. Espinoza be found releasable on or about June 1, 2018 after completing approximately six months in work release.
