- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received in this case.
- Mr. Kraus was seen for a .100 Parolability Hearing on June 21, 2017 at the Monroe Correctional Command – Special Offender Unit.
- **Summary Discussion**  
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Kraus is under the Board’s jurisdiction in King County Cause #78824 for Attempted Robbery in the First Degree and Robbery in the First Degree.

The crimes involved Mr. Kraus robbing a pharmacy in Seattle and two weeks later attempting to rob a cashier in a store but was not successful and fled. He was on parole for Credit Card Theft when these crimes were committed. Mr. Kraus was 22 years of age when he committed these crimes and he is currently 63 years of age.

Mr. Kraus' hearing has been continued three times from 2013 due to medical issues. During this time he has continued to incur infractions which include Making Drugs/Alcohol, Abusive Language, Strong-arming/Intimidation, Threatening and Refusing Cell/Housing Assignment.

After the last continued hearing Mr. Kraus requested another hearing and said he would participate. Mr. Kraus did not attend this hearing and did not participate in a psychological evaluation, so the evaluation was the result of a file review.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate to high risk to re-offend.

Infractions: Mr. Kraus has incurred 63 infractions and many of them include threatening behavior.

Mr. Kraus is compliant with his mental health plan.

Mr. Kraus was not at his hearing today to discuss any release planning.

- **Recommendation:** Not releasable – re-affirm 2013 decision to extend to statutory maximum and release on statutory maximum of 3-14-2019.
