- An updated prosecutor recommendation was received from Deputy Prosecutor Ione George for no release.

- Mr. Cupic was seen for a .100 Hearing at the Stafford Creek Corrections Center on September 11, 2018.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented the case.

Mr. Cupic is under the Board's jurisdiction in Kitsap County Cause 79-1-00320-2 for Robbery in the First Degree and Murder in the First Degree.

The crime of Robbery in the First Degree involved Mr. Cupic robbing a man who picked him up hitchhiking. The crime of Murder in the First Degree involved Mr. Cupic and a co-defendant following a woman, who was spotted

at a gas station, back to her work-place. She was kidnapped at gunpoint, sexually assaulted and shot seven times. Mr. Cupic was 21 or 22 years old at the time of these crimes and is currently 60 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a high risk to re-offend.

Mr. Cupic has committed 58 serious infractions in the last 38 years. He had a fight with another inmate in 2008, and his last infraction was in 2016 for being out of bounds.

Mr. Cupic has not completed much programming. He has completed Redemption and Roots of Success. However, Mr. Cupic said he is willing to do what the Board asks of him with regard to programming.

Mr. Cupic would like to release to his family in Lewis County, but admits he is not ready to be released.

- **Decision:** The Board finds Mr. Cupic not parolable and adds no time to his minimum term.
- **Reasons:**
 - **Needs additional offense specific treatment.**
 - **Assessed as a high risk for re-offense in his most recent psychological evaluation dated April 30, 2018.**
 - **Denies having committed a sexual assault as a component of his index offense.**
- **Next Action:** Schedule .100 hearing 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date (PERD).
- **Recommendations:** Mr. Cupic should continue with infraction free behavior and participate in offense specific treatment. Mr. Cupic denies participating in the sexual assault and therefore would not likely be admitted into the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP). However, he should make a request to participate in "Moving Forward" at the Airway Heights Corrections Center (AHCC).
