- Mr. Asa was seen for a release hearing on September 13, 2017 at the Cedar Creek Corrections Center.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Asa is being reviewed by the Board King County Cause 96-1-05033-1 for Murder in the Second Degree and Assault in the First Degree.

The crime involved Mr. Asa shooting and killing a woman and shooting a man at a Texaco Food Mart where he and his brother stopped to use the phone. Mr. Asa stated the woman had taken his hat and coat. Mr. Asa was 17 at the time of the crimes and he is currently 39 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Asa has committed several serious infractions with the last two occurring in 2015.

Mr. Asa has completed Stress/Anger Management but has not completed other offender change programs.

Mr. Asa has shown no remorse, nor has he taken responsibility for the crimes for which he has been convicted.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Mr. Asa be found not releasable under the Board's jurisdiction. He will release on his currently Earned Release Date of April 10, 2018 and will follow the orders of his judgement and Sentence.
