- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Savage was seen for a .100 Hearing on September 5, 2017 at the Monroe Correctional Complex – Twin Rivers Unit.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Savage is under the Board’s jurisdiction in Snohomish County Cause #79-1-00141-9 for Rape in the First Degree Count I.

The crime involved accosting and raping an 18 year old female as she was walking to school.

Mr. Savage committed multiple attacks on school girls in the Snohomish County area. He was initially charged with four separate counts of Rape in the First Degree and one count of Assault in the Second Degree. He

ultimately plead guilty to one count of Rape in the First Degree. He was 30 years old at the time of the crime and he is currently 69 years of age.

Mr. Savage paroled in January of 1988 and returned to prison as a violator in 1990 after committing and being convicted of Kidnapping in the Second Degree. This crime runs consecutively to the Rape in the First Degree.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate to high risk to re-offend.

Mr. Savage has had 27 serious infractions with the last one occurring in 2007 for staff interference.

Mr. Savage has not completed much programming and he is a high risk sex offender that has not completed SOTAP. The Board would like him complete SOTAP and the aftercare component.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Mr. Savage be found not releasable and extended to his statutory maximum of December 12, 2029.
 - Next action: Schedule a Cashaw Hearing. The Board will see him sooner if he completes the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP).
