- Mr. Bidon was seen for a .100 Hearing on September 21, 2017 at the Monroe Correctional Complex - MSU.
  
- **Summary Discussion**  
Ms. Balmert presented this case.

Mr. Bidon is under the Board's jurisdiction in King County Cause 86081 for Rape in the First Degree Count I and Assault in the First Degree Count II. He has previous convictions in King County Cause 72738 for Rape (While Armed) Count I and III and Sodomy (While Armed) Counts II and IV as well as Assault in the Second Degree (While Armed) Count V.

The crime involved an attack on a 15 year old girl as she walked to school in the morning. Mr. Bidon jumped out at her as she walked a wooded trail. He also drove her to another area where he raped and assaulted her. Mr. Bidon

was 25 years old at the time of the Rape and Assault and he is currently 64 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a low to moderate risk to re-offend.

Infractions: Mr. Bidon has had no serious infractions since 2002.

In 2011, Mr. Bidon received a Forensic Psychological Evaluation and was found to meet criteria for Civil Commitment. In 2016 Mr. Bidon had an updated Forensic Psychological Evaluation by the same doctor and was found to not meet criteria.

Mr. Bidon has completed the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program, Aftercare and chemical dependency treatment. He has completed many offender change programs.

Mr. Bidon has a comprehensive release plan which includes releasing to his wife. He has extensive community support.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Mr. Bidon be found parolable.

Next Action: Submit an offender release plan.
