- Mr. Grisby was seen for a .100 Hearing on September 19, 2017 at the Washington State Penitentiary.

- **Summary Discussion**
Elyse Balmert presented this case.

Mr. Grisby is under the Board's jurisdiction in King County Cause 85192 for Murder in the First Degree Count I, Count II, Count III, Count IV, Count VI and Assault in the First Degree Count V. All counts are to be served consecutively. Mr. Grisby paroled from Murder in the First Degree Count I to Murder in the First Degree Count II on May 28, 2001. The current hearing is to determine whether to parole Mr. Grisby to Murder in the First Degree Count III. He also has a Robbery out of Benton County for which he served his sentence.

The crime involved Mr. Grisby and a co-defendant entering a residence that was occupied by several adults and two small children. Both Mr. Grisby and his co-defendant were armed. Mr. Grisby and his co-defendant shot to death five people. One survived. Mr. Grisby was 39 years old at the time of these offenses and he is currently 77 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a medium to high risk to re-offend.

Mr. Grisby has had 24 infractions during his incarceration with the last one occurring in December of 2016 for a positive urinalysis.

Mr. Grisby has completed several programs to include Roots of Success; Redemption Program; CI Financial Literacy – 2015; Making a Good Brain Great – 2015; Roots of Success -2015; Making it Work – 2015; and Chemical Dependency Treatment in 2011. He also mentors younger inmates.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Mr. Grisby be found parolable to Count III.

Next Action: Schedule .100 Hearing 120 days prior to his earned release date on Count III.
