- Mr. Skinner was seen for a .100 Hearing on November 16, 2017 at Coyote Ridge Corrections Center.
  
- **Summary Discussion**  
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Skinner is under the Board's jurisdiction in Benton County Cause 99-1-00045-9 for Murder in the First Degree.

The crime involved the murder of a known adult female by multiple blows to the head in 1979. The presence of his sperm found at the scene was later tested and he was convicted of the murder in 2000. He alleges that he had sexual relationship with the victim and denies the crime. Mr. Skinner was 17 years old at the time of the murder and he is currently 55 years of age.

Risk assessment rate him as a moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Skinner has had a total of 8 serious infractions with the last one occurring in 2011 for drug use.

Mr. Skinner was found conditionally parolable to a Mutual Re-entry Plan (MRP) in 2015. He has programmed well and has excellent reports.

His release plan is well developed to include a faith based transition house and he has good family support.

Mr. Skinner has served the minimum term received by the court minus good time.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that he be found parolable.

**Next Action:** Submit an offender release plan.
