- An updated prosecutor recommendation was received for no release.

- Mr. Stanphill was seen for a .100 Hearing on November 15, 2017 at the Washington State Penitentiary.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Stanphill is under the Board's jurisdiction in Franklin County Cause 3306 for Rape in the Second Degree.

The crime involved Mr. Stanphill setting up a blind date under an alias with an unknown 18 year old female. He told the victim there would be a party, and when there was none, she returned to her car. He persuaded her to return to the apartment where he physically and sexually assaulted her. He was 20 at the time of the crime and is currently 63 years of age.

Subsequent to the rape, Mr. Stanphill fled to Arizona where he committed another rape and was finally apprehended in California.

Prior criminal history includes two rapes in 1972 and 1973 and a conviction for Petty Theft, Burglary and being a fugitive from justice in 1973.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a high risk to re-offend.

Mr. Stanphill has had over 100 serious infractions. Seventeen of those infractions occurred since his last hearing in 2011. He is currently in the Intensive Management Unit at the Penitentiary for drug infractions.

Mr. Stanphill has been terminated three times from the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP) and has continued drug use in prison.

Mr. Stanphill has not developed a release plan but states his fiancée is an option.

- **Recommendation:** Not parolable, add 65 months to his minimum term to complete the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP).
Next Action: Schedule .100 Hearing 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date (PERD).
