- **Summary Discussion**

Mrs. Ramdell-Gilkey presented the case. Mr. Andrade is currently under the jurisdiction of the Indeterminate Sentence Review Board (ISRB) in Franklin County Cause #95-1-5373-9 for Assault in the First Degree. The time start is June 1, 2015. This count was consecutive to one count of Murder in the First Degree with a time start of January 10, 1996. Mr. Andrade was 16 years old when he committed his crimes and is currently 37 years of age.

Mr. Andrade was seen for a Release Hearing at the Airway Heights Corrections Center on September 27, 2016. A deferred decision was taken at that hearing.

Risk assessments are low to medium. This crime was a gang related shooting over turf wars with another gang. Shots were fired at an apartment building of opposing gang members.

Mr. Andrade has a detainer to Mexico. He has taken what little programming is available to him. He has earned certificates of completion for Making it Work, and Great Truths of the Bible. He has also completed courses for writing and math and obtained his GED. The Board would like him to participate in Stress/Anger Management, Thinking for a Change and chemical dependency if he is allowed by the Department of Corrections.

Mr. Andrade's Institutional behavior includes 45 major infractions to include a 2013 aggravated assault on another inmate. He said he quit the gang in 2005 but has had gang related infractions since that time. Board Members would like to see a longer period of infraction free behavior.

Mr. Andrade was seen for a Release Hearing at the Airway Heights Corrections Center on September 27, 2016. A deferred decision was taken at that hearing.

Mr. Andrade has a detainer to Mexico. His release plan includes deportation to his Grandfather's farm in Mexico.

Recommendation: Not releasable – re-submit petition in thirty-six months in October 2019 and obtain additional recommended programming.

Mr. Sahlberg disagrees with the recommendation for further confinement. He stated that Mr. Andrade has been employed and taken all programming that was available to him. He expressed that he has been denied programs due to his ICE detainer and he does have a strong release plan. Mr. Andrade may need a request from the Board for DOC to make an exception to current program eligibility to aid in his transition.
