ABOUT THE FACILITY

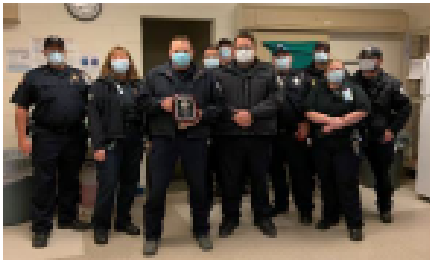
