



Eligibility for Notification Services

When an offender is convicted of a domestic violence court order violation or a violent, sex serious drug, or felony harassment offense and is sentenced to confinement in Prison, the following individuals will be offered an opportunity to enroll in the victim/witness notification service:

- a) The victims and witnesses of the offender's crime of conviction,
- b) The next of kin, if the crime of conviction was homicide, or
- c) Anyone identified in writing by the Prosecuting Attorney as eligible for the notification service.

You are entitled to Advanced Notification by the Department of Corrections, if you are a victim or witness of one of the below eligible crimes:
