Subject: First Incarcerated Individual Death Due to COVID-19

On Wednesday, June 17, 2020, an incarcerated patient of the Washington state correctional system passed away due to COVID-19. Victor Bueno, 63 years of age, had been transported to a local medical center on May 31, 2020 for treatment of COVID-19 where he remained until the time of his passing. Prior to his transfer for outside medical treatment, Mr. Bueno was housed in I Unit.

As we shared yesterday, with the assistance of the Department of Health (DOH) a plan is being developed to test all employees and MSC incarcerated individuals for COVID-19. More information on the process for testing will be available in the coming days.

As of June 17, 2020, Camas H Tier is on restricted movement due to being quarantined. As an additional safety measure, all staff and incarcerated individuals at MSU will be required to wear surgical masks. Individuals outside of their cubicle/cell area will practice social distancing while wearing their surgical mask.
