SUBJECT: Reduced Commissary Spending Limits

Due to the ongoing response to COVID-19 and impacts to available staffing resources, effective December 10, 2020, there will be a temporary change to the commissary order limits. In accordance with [DOC 200.210 Prison Commissary](#), the maximum spending amounts will be adjusted as follows:
