

**SUBJECT: AHCC Temporary Menu Changes Extended through January 19, 2021**

As previously communicated in a memo on [December 21, 2020](#), due to the ongoing response to COVID-19 and impacts to available resources, food service operations at AHCC are serving two cold and one hot meals. This temporary menu change will remain in effect through January 19, 2021 and will be reevaluated at that time.

For individuals on mainline, you can expect cold meals at breakfast and dinner, and a hot meal at lunch. Individuals who receive modified diets will continue to receive those diets as they are currently being served.

The temporary menu continues to meet the nutritional needs of the incarcerated population as set forth in [DOC Policy 240.100a](#) and utilizes the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the Dietary Guidelines for Americans meal patterns.
