SUBJECT: **MCC Weekly COVID-19 Update**

At this time the direction from Headquarters is that the MCC Staff Wellness Center will remain closed. If this decision changes we will send out an update.

On Wednesday, February 24, 2021 the Twin Rivers Unit (TRU) Inmate Kitchen (IK) workers were put on quarantine status as a precautionary measure while the mapping process was completed due to a potential COVID-19 exposure. Following a thorough mapping process the individuals were removed from quarantine status on Thursday, February 25, 2021.

The Monroe Correctional Complex (MCC) incarcerated population were provided comfort bags the week of February 22, 2021. These comfort bags included items such as chips, crackers, coffee, and other snacks. These comfort bags were purchased using the Incarcerated Individual Betterment Fund (IIBF).

The mandatory use of surgical masks has been extended until further notice per the [memo](#) sent from Secretary Sinclair on February 25, 2021.

To preserve the health and wellbeing of ourselves and our co-workers, it is important that we all continue to stay physically six (6) feet or more apart from one another when possible, wash our hands frequently, and properly wear the appropriate PPE.
