Subject: COVID-19 Weekly Update

As we make progress in our attempts to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 I am glad to announce that we are officially off of outbreak status at Stafford Creek. With that being said, we must still maintain our vigilance in ensuring we are social distancing, wearing masks and enforcing this with the incarcerated individuals.

We are developing plans and schedules to resume movements to P Building for programming. This will begin to rollout in a week and the schedules will be shared. This will include a cohorting plans for the use of P Building by certain units on certain days. The programs will have limited seating and barriers will be put in place as well as signage on the floors and seating to indicate where it is appropriate to be seated.

The individuals housed in F- Unit South will be moved to H-4 Unit today. F-Unit South will then be cleaned and staged for any potential second outbreak as needed. G Unit A-tier will house individuals on quarantine status, primarily for intake separation individuals coming in from as transfers.

We will continue to make some moves of individuals from unit to unit to facilitate a cohort plan for Correctional Industries workers. Unit Managers are still authorized to make moves between units and inter-unit moves as well.

Our current movement schedules, and work and program schedules will remain in effect indefinitely or until we receive directions that indicate a change is needed.

We appreciate your efforts in managing our response to COVID-19 at Stafford Creek.
