SUBJECT: MCCCW Limited Area Outbreak

On April 7, 2021, Mission Creek Corrections Center for Women (MCCCW) confirmed that a staff member tested positive for COVID-19. Additionally, on April 19, 2021, MCCCW received confirmation that four (4) incarcerated individuals, housed in Gold Unit, had tested positive.

In a consultation with Headquarters Clinical Leadership and Prisons Operations Leadership, the determination was made that MCCCW would be removed from outbreak status, and Gold Unit, the only affected area, would be placed on a Limited Area Outbreak.

Gold Unit remains quarantined and unable to participate in visitation, the rest of the facility will continue normal operations. There have been no new COVID-19 positive tests.

Similarly, it is vital that we continue to follow the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines, ensuring to follow the six (6) foot social distancing rule, washing your hands, and keeping all areas of the institution sanitized. Please remain diligent in wearing your masks at all times, as your safety is a priority.

Corrections is committed to everyone's safety. We will continue to communicate with you as we progress through this pandemic.
