

SUBJECT: Active Screening Questions Updated – Serial Testing

As of August 20, 2021, the active screening questions have been updated, and are attached to this message. Please use these updated questions for active screening in your work areas.

As school resumes and summer transitions to fall, COVID-19 cases and other illnesses are on the rise. It is important to please stay home if you are sick. COVID-19 remains a serious threat to health and safety, and it is important to continue following all related protocols.

As previously announced, serial testing will continue regardless of vaccination status until further notice. This includes serial testing for vaccinated individuals diagnosed with COVID-19 more than 90 days prior until we have further information about effectiveness of immunity against the delta variant in these individuals.

It is our responsibility to continue ensuring the health and safety of our fellow staff members, those under our jurisdiction and our friends and family. By frequently washing your hands, socially distancing, and getting vaccinated for COVID-19 and influenza, you can do your part to stay safe and healthy.
