SUBJECT: CRCC COVID-19 Limited Area Outbreak

On September 6, 2021 Coyote Ridge Corrections Center (CRCC) confirmed that twelve (12) incarcerated individuals on Sage East tested positive for COVID-19. As a result of the positive test results, and in conjunction with clinical staff it was determined to place Sage East on limited Area Outbreak status.

Additionally, On September 15, 2021, H-Unit was placed on limited cluster status. Staff will be serial testing twice a week and the offenders will all be tested today on September 16, 2021. This does not affect visitation currently.

While Sage East-Unit will remain quarantined and unable to participate in visitation, the rest of the facility will continue normal operations.

It is imperative that everyone continue to wear a Surgical Mask, or appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), and practice social distancing at all times and hold the incarcerated responsible to meet these standards. Similarly, it is vital that we continue to follow the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines, ensuring to follow the six (6) foot social distancing rule, washing your hands, and keeping areas of the institution sanitized.

Corrections is committed to everyone's safety. We will continue to communicate with you as we progress through this pandemic.
