SUBJECT: COVID-19 Vaccination Incentive Bags for Residents and Incarcerated

Correctional Industries and the Department of Corrections have collaborated to provide Vaccination Incentive Kits for the incarcerated individuals in Prisons and Work Release residents who have chosen or will choose to be vaccinated against the COVID-19 virus.

During November, prison and work release facilities will receive Vaccination Incentive Kits for distribution to vaccinated incarcerated individuals. Facilities will then develop plans locally on how to distribute the Vaccination Incentive Kits to you, if you have already received COVID-19 vaccinations, and for those that choose to initiate COVID-19 vaccinations in the future.

If you have not yet been vaccinated for COVID-19, but wish to become vaccinated, please contact the medical team at your facility to schedule your appointment.

Your facility will provide you with more specific details on how they plan to distribute these incentive bags to you!

- 4 packages of Top Ramen
- 1 Honey Bun
- 1 Instant Oatmeal
- 1 Keefe Coffee
- 1 Brown Rice
- 1 Creamy Peanut Butter
- 1 Wheat Crackers
- 1 Cheddar Cheese Bar
- 1 pre-franked envelope
