**SUBJECT:** CBCC COVID-19 Weekly Update Memo

Effective, November 15, 2021 Clallam Bay Correction Center (CBCC) is off of outbreak and quarantine status.

In a consultation with Headquarters Clinical Leadership and Prisons Operations Leadership, the determination was made that CBCC would be removed from outbreak status. All incarcerated individuals tested have had two negative tests on days 5-7 and 10-14 of a 14-day period and have been on quarantine status for 14 days from their last contact with COVID positive or symptomatic patients.

It is imperative that everyone continue to wear a Surgical Mask, or appropriate [Personal Protective Equipment \(PPE\)](#), and practice social distancing at all times and hold the incarcerated responsible to meet these standards. Similarly, it is vital that we continue to follow the [Centers for Disease Control \(CDC\) guidelines](#), ensuring to follow the six (6) foot social distancing rule, washing your hands, and keeping areas of the institution sanitized.

You have all put in a tremendous amount of time, effort, and hard work to get us through the outbreak. We would not have been successful without all of the dedication and commitment of our great staff. Thank you!
