SUBJECT: CBCC COVID-19 Facility Wide Outbreak

On January 14, 2022, Clallam Bay Correction Center (CBCC) was placed on Facility Wide Outbreak status and began testing the entire population. We currently have fifty-eight (58) incarcerated individuals on medical isolation, twelve (12) new positives out of B Unit and one (1) new positive out of D Unit. We have 324 incarcerated individuals on quarantine from all units.

Current quarantine or medical isolation protocols are in effect for the following areas:

- A Unit
 - o Red and Green pods remain on quarantine
 - o Brown pod houses recovered incarcerated individuals and has normal operations
- B Unit remains on quarantine
- C Unit
 - o Red and Green pods house medical isolation cases
 - o Brown pod houses high-risk quarantine cases
- D unit has been placed on quarantine
- F Unit, RHU, remains on quarantine/medical isolation

CBCC has 324 pending tests from last facility wide COVID-19 testing on Tuesday, January 18.

We continue to follow the [Prisons Division Cluster and Outbreak Checklist](#) and remain in restricted movement at this time.

It is imperative that everyone continue to wear a surgical mask or appropriate [personal protective equipment \(PPE\)](#). Similarly, it is vital that we continue to follow the [Centers for Disease Control \(CDC\) guidelines](#): ensuring to follow the six (6) foot physical distancing rule, washing your hands, and keeping high-touch areas of the facility sanitized.

Corrections is committed to everyone's safety. We will continue to communicate with you as we progress through this pandemic.
