SUBJECT: COVID-19 Weekly Update

The Monroe Correctional Complex (MCC) continues to be in Facility Wide Outbreak status.

Temporarily, incarcerated workers working for Correctional Industries (CI) in the following areas will make \$1.10/hour + \$20/weekly incentive pay. See the posted announcement from CI.

- a. Food Service
- b. Commissary
- c. Transportation/Warehouse
- d. Laundry

Temporarily, when an incarcerated worker is unable to perform their normal work duties due to the current COVID-19 outbreak status of their facility they will receive a \$30 stipend. **This only applies to the individuals who have been on quarantine status over the last few weeks.** Individuals who are working and earn less than \$30 will receive a stipend as a separate deposit in the amount of the difference. The calculations for January will be processed solely by the MCC Business Office and posted to accounts a week after MCC monthly payroll has posted. The stipend will be paid as a Class III gratuity, regardless of the individual's normal class of work. Stipend pay will continue until the facility is no longer under COVID-19 outbreak status. This applies to DOC Facility jobs, NOT CI.
