SUBJECT: CBCC COVID-19 Weekly Update Memo (corrected)

On January 25, 2022, Clallam Bay Correction Center (CBCC) was placed on Facility Wide Outbreak status and began testing the entire population. As of February 11, 2022, we have had 170 positive COVID-19 cases in our incarcerated population in the last 30 days. We have had our first facility wide round of tests come back negative.

Quarantine or medical isolation protocols are in effect for the following areas:

- **B Unit**
 - Brown pod remains on quarantine
- **C Unit has been closed due to CBCC having no cases on isolation status**
- **D Unit**
 - Red pod remains on quarantine
 - Green pod tier I remains on quarantine
- **F Unit, RHU**
 - Remains on quarantine/medical isolation

The following areas are running with normal operations:

- A Unit
- B Unit red pod and green pod
- D Unit brown pod (all) and green pod (tiers G/H only)

Facility wide COVID-19 testing occurred on February 8, 2022, and results were all negative. Next testing day will be Tuesday February 15. We will need one more facility wide round of tests to be negative to come off facility wide outbreak. We continue to follow the [Prisons Division Cluster and Outbreak Checklist](#) and remain in restricted movement at this time.

It is imperative that everyone continue to wear a surgical mask or appropriate [personal protective equipment \(PPE\)](#). Similarly, it is vital that we continue to follow the [Centers for Disease Control \(CDC\) guidelines](#); ensuring to follow the six (6) foot physical-distancing rule, washing your hands, and keeping high-touch areas of the facility sanitized.

Corrections is committed to everyone's safety. We will continue to communicate with you as we progress through this pandemic.
