SUBJECT: CBCC Facility Wide Outbreak Resolution

Effective, February 17, 2022, Clallam Bay Correction Center (CBCC) has been removed from outbreak and quarantine status.

Per the [Prisons Division Cluster & Outbreak Checklist](#) and in a consultation with Headquarters Clinical Leadership and Prisons Operations Leadership, the determination was made that CBCC would be removed from outbreak status. All incarcerated individuals tested have had two negative tests on days 5-7 and 10-14 of a 14-day period and have been on quarantine status for 14 days from their last contact with COVID positive or symptomatic patients

It is imperative that everyone continue to wear a surgical mask or appropriate [personal protective equipment \(PPE\)](#). Similarly, it is vital that we continue to follow the [Centers for Disease Control \(CDC\) guidelines](#): ensuring to follow the six (6) foot physical-distancing rule, washing your hands, and keeping high-touch areas of the facility sanitized.

Corrections is committed to everyone's safety. We will continue to communicate with you as we progress through this pandemic.
