- An updated prosecutor recommendation from 1990 was received recommending no release.

- Mr. Monroe was seen for a .100 hearing at the Monroe Correctional Complex – Twin Rivers Unit on January 8, 2019.

- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Rongen presented this case.

Mr. Monroe is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Clark County Cause 79-1-00263-1 for Statutory Rape in the First Degree Count I and Burglary in the Second Degree Count II.

Mr. Monroe also served on the following convictions which have reached their statutory maximum to include Pierce County Cause 42771 Burglary in the Second Degree Count I; Burglary in the Second Degree Count II; and Clark County Cause 6581 Second Degree Burglary.

The crime involved Mr. Monroe entering a home through an unlocked door at approximately midnight. He was nude when he entered the home. He checked the residence and entered the bedroom of a sleeping five year old female. He took her from her bed, laid her on the floor and put a pillow over her face and masturbated and sexually assaulted her. He was 31 years old at the time and is currently 70 years of age.

Mr. Monroe has a Forensic Psychological Evaluation dated April 18, 2018 which determines that he meets criteria for civil commitment. This is the second evaluation that meets with the first one being in 2011.

Mr. Monroe completed the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP) but has an extensive offense history and continues to have deviant thoughts and has masturbated to them as recent as 2017.

Mr. Monroe has completed Bridges to Life and is a carpenter helper. Mr. Monroe would like to release to the House of Mercy in King County. He has support from a brother in Los Angeles and a sister in Vancouver.

- **Decision**

The panel recommends that Mr. Monroe be found not parolable.

- **Reasons:**

- **Assessed as a Moderate Risk to sexually reoffend and a Level Three for community notification.**
- **2011 & 2018 Forensic Psychological Evaluation saying he meets the criteria as a sexually violent predator.**
- **2014 Psychological Evaluation that assesses Mr. Monroe as moderate-high risk to sexually reoffend.**
- **Mr. Monroe continues to struggle with deviant thoughts and inability to control those thoughts as recent as 2017.**
- **Cross-over type of sex offender with both minor and adult victims and both hands on and hands off types of crimes which increases his risk.**

- **Next Action:** Schedule a .100 hearing 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date (PERD). The Board requests an updated Forensic Psychological Evaluation for the next hearing and DOC psychological evaluation.
