- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Stoudamire was seen for a .100 hearing at the Monroe Correctional Complex – Washington State Reformatory on January 8, 2019.

- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Rongen presented this case.

Mr. Stoudamire is under the jurisdiction of the Board in King County Cause 87618 Count II Murder in the First Degree. He also has convictions under this cause number for Assault in the First Degree Counts I and III which have reached their statutory maximum.

The crimes involved three female victims over a three day period in Seward Park. Two of the victims were attacked from behind and were able to escape. The second victim in this case was stabbed several times. Her body

was found with boot marks on her neck and back. Mr. Stoudamire was 15 years old at the time of the crimes and is currently 56 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as an overall moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Stoudamire has had no violent infractions since 1995.

Mr. Stoudamire has been doing well since the Board last saw him. He is working as a data clerk in the Correctional Industries (CI) Kitchen and receives excellent evaluations. He attends Interaction Transition, Catholic Services and has completed Bridges to Life. He has participated in the Global Leadership Summit and is on the Christian Community Board. He is also a facilitator for Alternatives to Violence.

The Board acknowledges that Mr. Stoudamire is doing well within the facility. However, he has limited insight into the murder and assaults that were committed.

Mr. Stoudamire would like to release to his wife.

- **Decision**

Found not parolable. Add 60 months to his minimum term.

- **Reasons:**

- **Mr. Stoudamire's version of his index murder and associated behavior does not match file material and is simply not believable. This calls into question his motivations for offending and as such whether or not he has received appropriate treatment programs.**
- **Mr. Stoudamire has limited insight into the murder and attacks on two other women provoking doubt about his ability to understand his criminogenic treatment needs.**
- **Assessed as a Moderate-High risk to reoffend on the VRAG-R**

Next Action: Schedule .100 120 days prior to parole eligibility review date (PERD).
